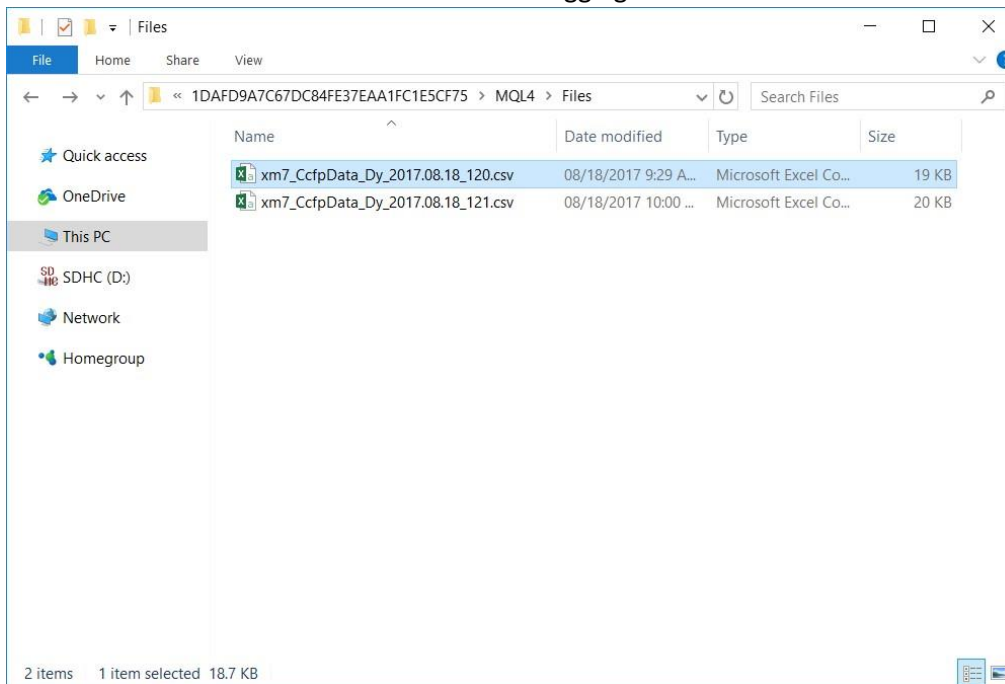


Steps for creating Excel Chart from Xm7 EA log files

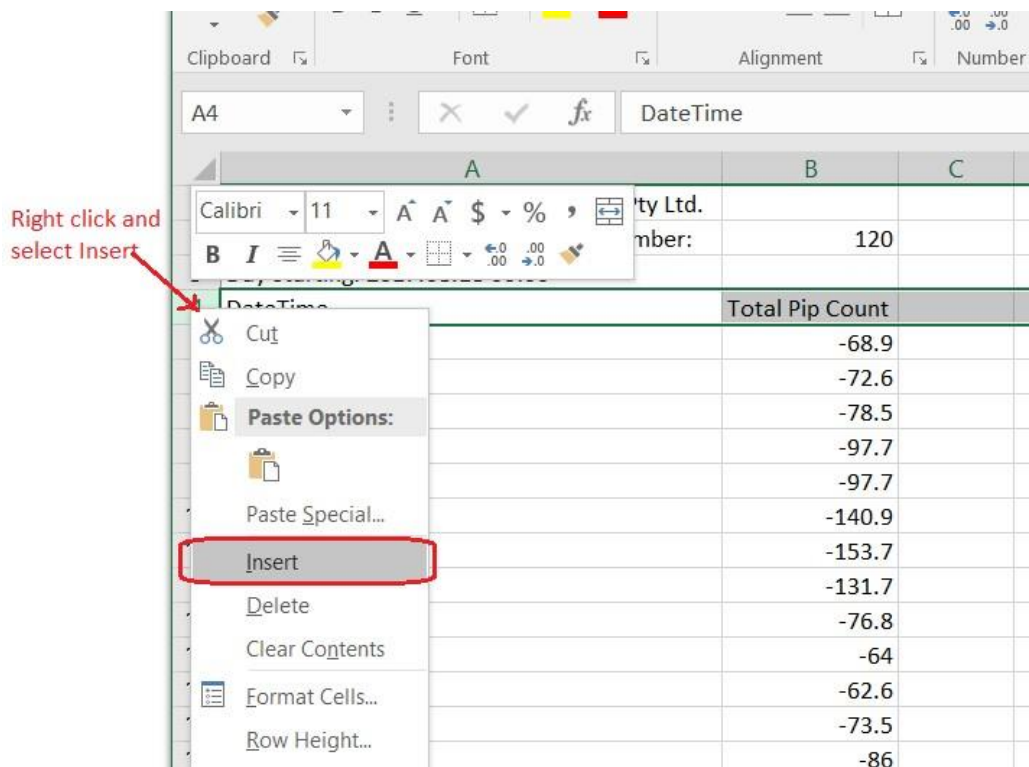
1. Navigate to MQL4\Files folder. If you have enabled pip logging in xm7 EA you will see the csv files created by xm7 ea in this folder. See [Post 779](#) for how to enable logging in xm7 ea.



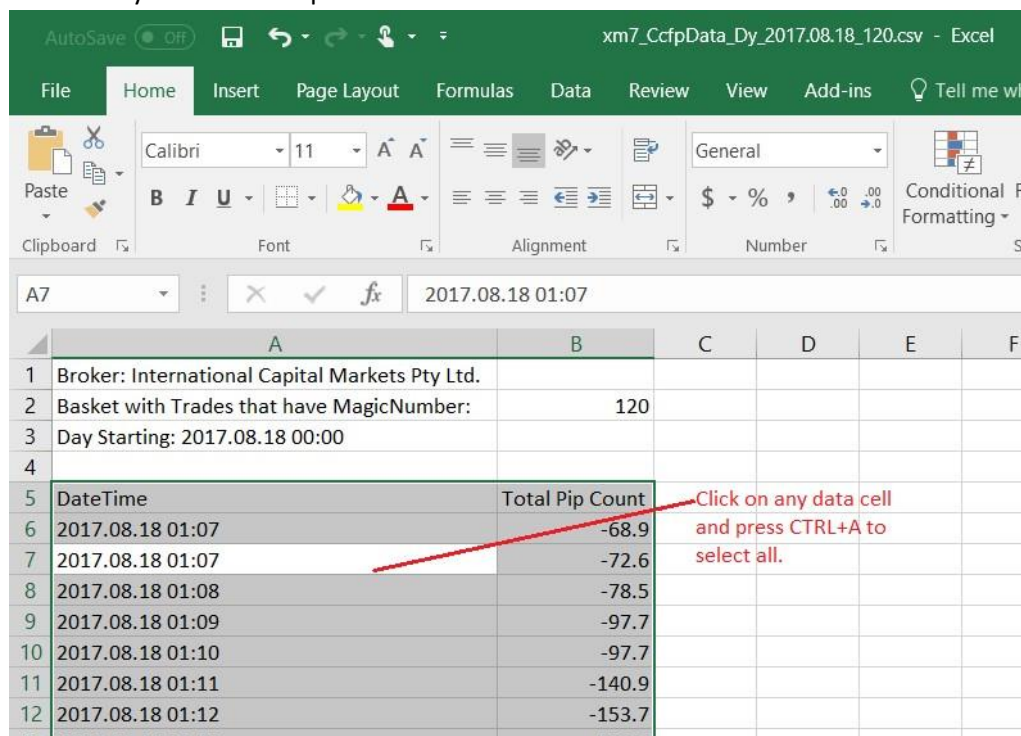
2. Open the csv file in Excel.

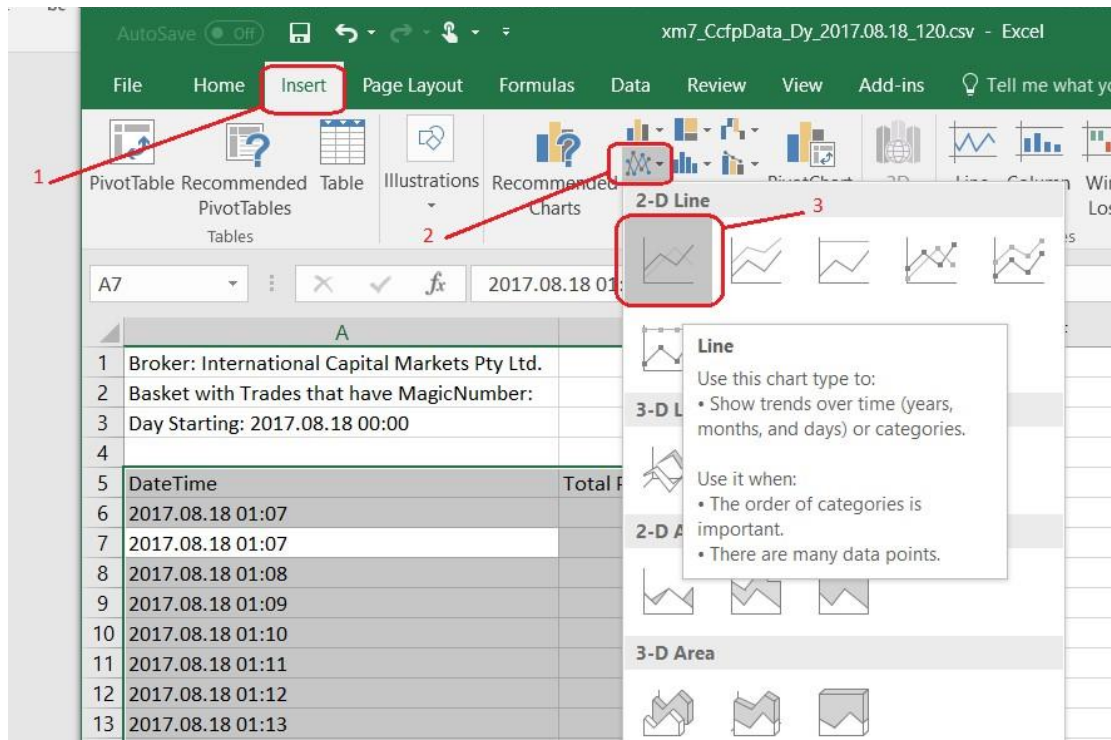
3. Insert a new row above the DateTime row (Row 4). Right click on Row 4 and select Insert.



4. Click on any data cell and press CTRL+A to select all.



5. Now, while the data is selected, click on Insert tab in Excel and select Line chart.



6. This will insert a line chart for the data range selected. Now you can resize and adjust the chart as you wish.
