My style of trading is this

A set up 1 pair (GU example)

A- set up 2nd pair

B set up 3rd pair

B- Set UP (NJ for example)

I add more positions on A set up and ignore lesser desired pairs so in essence instead of having 4-5 different pairs going I load up on few larger positions which is condensing my trades. So to me adding new positions to exiting A set up is equal to trading a different pair even better because you already seeing the results.

GU I have about 10 positions. I could of had 5 different pairs with 2 positions each but I dislike this way of trading. To me I prefer zeroing in for the kill not scattering myself all over the board. That's just me what works logically for me.

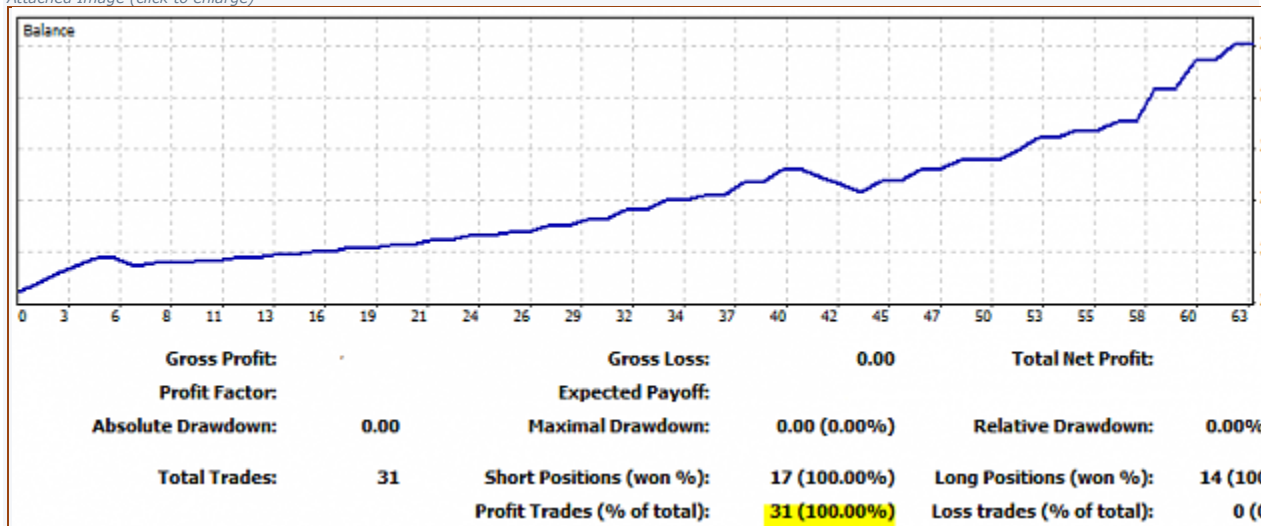

Here is how to trade pivots.

As price travels progressively away from weekly pivot it becomes more likely to go into correction.

61 S/R key zone 78R/S is Scott Carney's last chance for reversal (spikes stops taken before reversal) 100R/S another major zone.

Should price smash 100 S/R then you are in strong trend supported by fundamentals.

Pivots can be traded both with the trend and against. I personally don't subscribe to typical bookish mentally that if previous H4 is bear then assumption should be another bear candle. This is very wrong way to look at the markets. Markets are in constant motion and within 1 H4 candle price can move opposite over 100pips against previous candle so its not about previous candles but where price is in relative to pivots. In simple terms **Location** is what is important.

**I trade 15-30min** charts however bigger works as well.

TDI is our friend. When price hit major pivots we wait for TDI to turn thus confirm the move. Sharp angles important when its almost horizontal PA is weak or consolidating thus avoid trading. PA is king always!

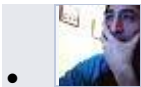

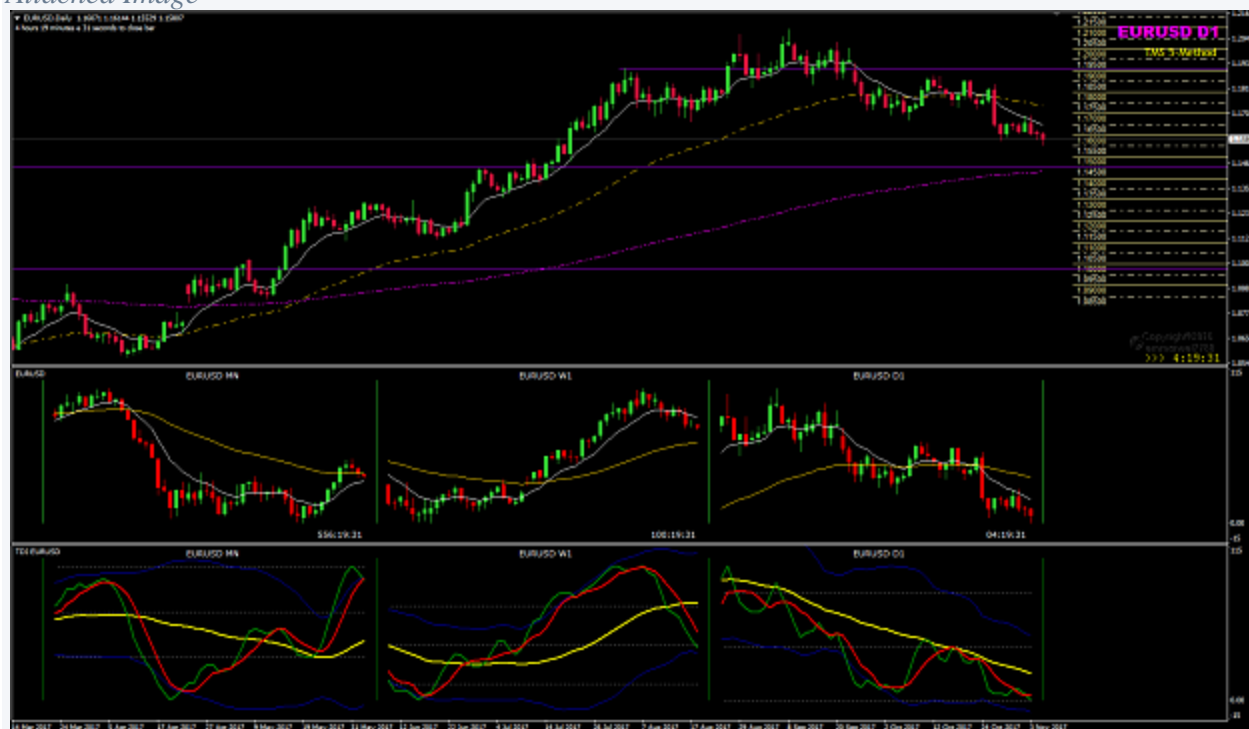

The RBA has dialled back its inflation forecasts

The Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) has just released its latest quarterly Statement on Monetary Policy (SoMP), including updated projections on GDP growth, inflation and unemployment over the next few years.

Today's forecasts are the first time the RBA has forgone the use of ranges, opting instead to make its forecasts to the nearest quarter percentage point. This was announced last month, and was widely expected by financial markets.

So how have they changed?

The most noticeable tweak involves the bank's underlying inflation forecasts, those which are of most importance on the outlook for interest rates, with the bank now forecasting that it will move back to the bottom of its 2-3% target range by the middle of 2019.

Not *in* the target band, but at the *bottom* of the target band.

In its previous forecasts, the midpoint had underlying inflation hitting 2% by the end of 2018 before moving back to 2.5% during 2019.

Based on these forecasts, the bank now thinks it will take longer for inflationary pressures to build.

That has implications on the outlook for interest rates, suggesting it could take longer for the RBA to begin normalising policy.

The bank's headline inflation forecasts have also been lowered from those previously offered in August.

Outside of inflation, the board also tweaked its unemployment forecasts for the end of 2019. It now sees Australia's unemployment rate sitting at 5.25% in two years time, below the 5.5% midpoint level offered in its previous forecasts.

Although an upgrade, the outcome suggests wage pressures over the next couple of years — a key factor on the outlook for inflationary pressures — will remain weak.

"There is uncertainty about how much wage growth will pick up in response to improved labour market conditions and the associated reduction in spare capacity," the bank says.

"More firms have been indicating that they are finding it difficult to find suitable labour, which might lead to wage growth picking up more quickly than anticipated.

"On the other hand, the experience of low wage growth in many countries with tighter labour markets suggests that structural factors such as

technological change and globalisation have had an important bearing on wage outcomes and could continue to do so for some time yet.” Australia’s full employment rate, or NAIRU, is seen by many analysts to currently sit at or just below 5%. An unemployment rate forecast of 5.25% by the end of 2019 implies that despite a high degree of uncertainty, wage pressures are likely to remain benign. Again, along with the downgrade to its inflation forecasts, this argues against the need for a near-term lift in interest rates. On the outlook for economic growth, the bank’s new GDP forecasts were much the same as those offered in August. It now sees GDP growth at 2.75% by the end of June next year, down fractionally on the 3% midpoint it offered in its previous forecasts. It also made a small reduction in its forecast for the end of 2019, trimming it by 25 basis points to 3.25%. Outside of those tweaks, its forecasts were unchanged. Making the downgrades to its inflation forecasts even more significant, it came despite the bank making significant changes to its Australian dollar and Brent crude forecasts. Over the forecast period, it sees the AUD/USD and AUD trade-weighted index (TWI) at 77 cents and 65 respectively, down from 80 cents at 67 in August. It also made a significant upgrade to its Brent forecast, seeing it average at \$63 per barrel, up from \$53 per barrel three months ago. Those assumptions should help to boost inflationary pressures. However, even with those tailwinds, the bank still sees inflation lifting at an even slower pace than before. These forecasts also use current market pricing for interest rates, another significant development. Markets don’t have a full 25 basis point rate hike priced until early 2019. So if rates were to increase by then, and the RBA’s forecasts and assumptions are correct, it still only sees underlying inflation at 2%. **All up, it suggests the RBA is still a long way from lifting interest rates, as pointed out by Robert Rennie, Global Head of Strategy at Westpac, on Twitter.**

I think if you happen to get in on great number say example GU at 3050 you could hold longer building trend based trades. This system is flexible both position building or quick swing trading. What I am saying is pivots allow flexible logical trading. It's my road map.

Clean your charts from MA's and start thinking in terms of market makers and how and which direction they are aggregating their positions. I think they often take profit at 61-100 pivots and why price does what it does. MM know what typical retail traders do loaded indicator charts that assumes certain outcome which is false outlook. In basic terms MM goal is to separate you from your money but you must fight back cleverly by reducing lot sizes widening stops and getting in increments this way you are a moving target not static duck with hard SL in place waiting to be taken out.

I trade street smart manner with one eye on pivots another on news fundamentals.

Anyone who says everything is in the chart is clueless. This garbage has been paraded by typical retail trader who is too lazy to read on fundies and often gets overrun on key events.

Hedge funds Market makers positions are 80% based on fundamentals and only 20% on technical. This is established fact and you can Google and read about it.

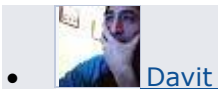

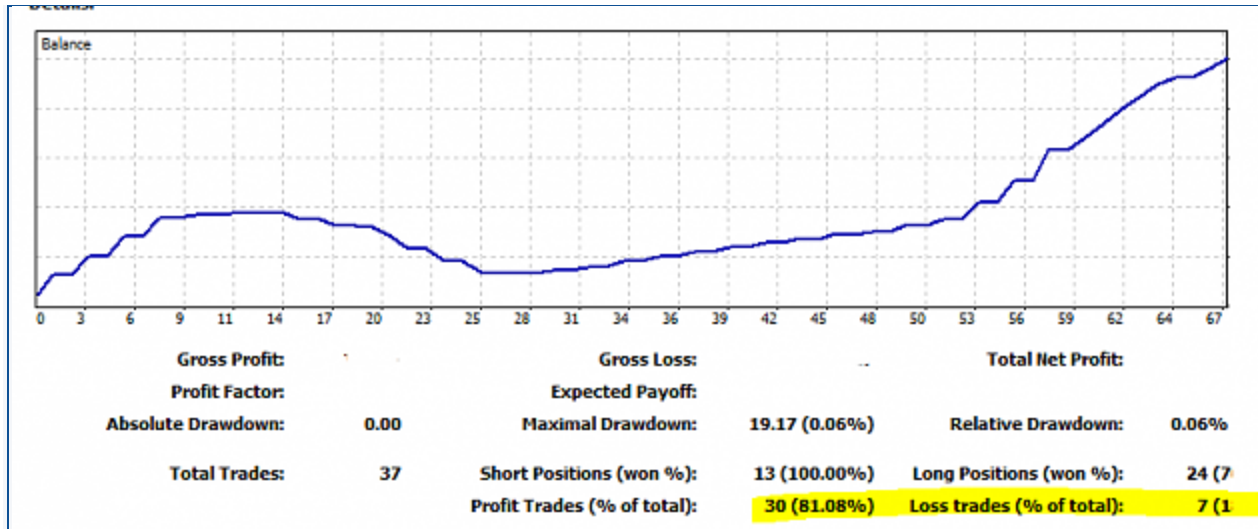

EA in particular is primed for correction. Can it go higher? Yes since I don't know the future that's possibility. Stay safe. Don't force trades

I have red positions on EJ EU EA none that are detrimental to account. If I think I should close these trades I usually go cutting in increments -25% then wait to see how PA is going. Basic idea is getting in incrementally and getting out same manner.

Trading any system requires good sample size. This is true for this system as well. Having some red trades are normal but you must look at the overall quarterly manner. Zoom out don't get depressed by your trades now. You must develop the confidence in trading. Rough rides and green rides all part of the game.

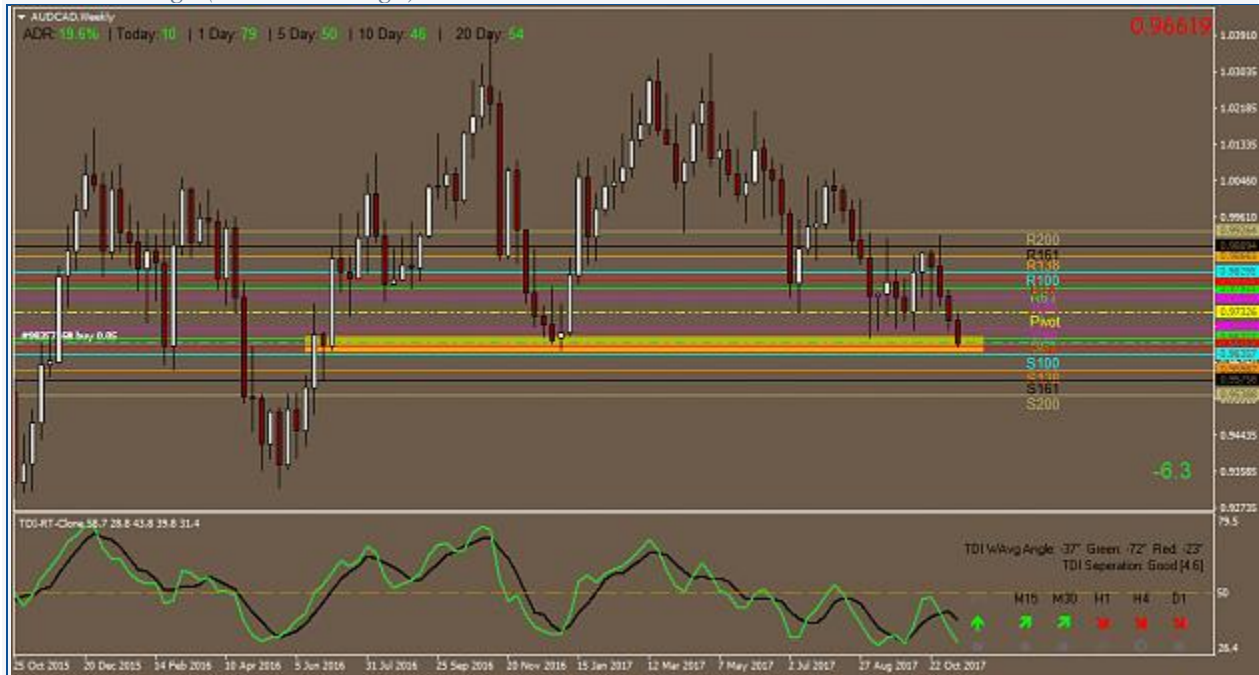

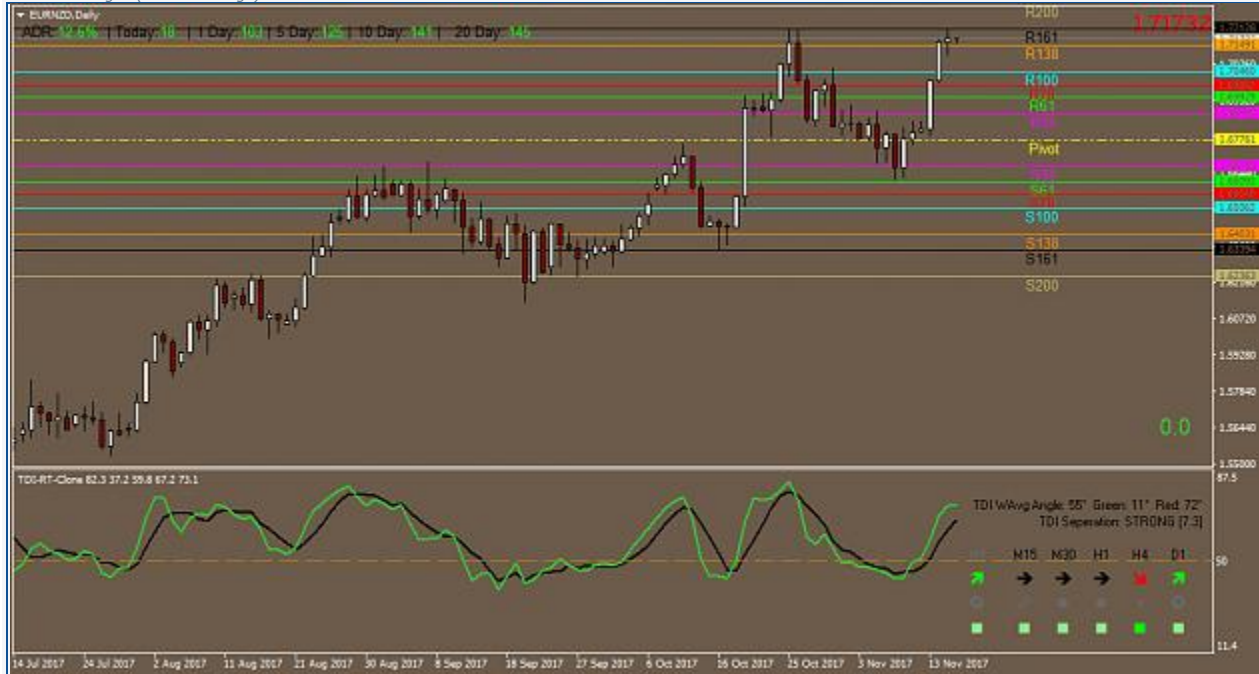

Good Morning guys

I want to clarify and explain how I trade. You might be reading lot of shit at TMS about me (why they talk about me is puzzling) but its important you understand.

#### 1. Position building

I enter positions at key levels 61-100 then scale in. My initial positions could be red however its part of how I trade.

If intended invested lot is 1 full lot and I have 2 small positions using only 20% of intended lot is not adding to losers but continuing BUILDING A POSITION as long as intended reasons of getting in is still valid.

Example you started shorting UJ at 1325 at 61R and price went to 1350 you added 2nd position this is not adding to losers even though clearly 1st position is red.

Your aim is to capture a price as a unit consists of 5-10 positions think like net fishing your entire net is your positions not just outer edges.

Think of a cat. Your 1st position is only hitting the ears but entire animal is still not covered. This is counter intuitive when most if not all trading books recommend cut your losses early. Well that's true if you went in with single full lot...which is not what I am doing. My entire distance which could be as much as 100 pips is my territory of operation.

Example I went long on AN at 1005 price dropped 50 pips lower in my way of trading I am like great I can add better positions and once all in just wait ALLOWING time to do its thing. Same scenario happened last week on GU my initial positions were red then collected ALL positions in profit less then 5 days later.

Time is a factor in trading! This is critical to understand

When to pull the plug. When clearly you are against strong trend and fundamentally you are in wrong side and your DD is not acceptable anymore. Everyone's DD is different. MY cut out point is different then yours. Point is I trade building positions mainly on swings. Some times that fails as every honest trader knows you can't win them all. You dust it off and continue on. Its a marathon.

To me successful trader is looking at larger picture. If out of 4 quarters I win 3 and lose 1 that's successful trading by the end of the year.

In restaurant business there are months things are slow like right after Dec holidays and entire Jan Feb everything quiets down and most restaurants lose money in this months until Spring kicks in. Should you close your business in Jan? When you are making a profit 8 months out of 12 months?

This is Simple logic. Trading is a business and you are going to have bad weeks even a month or two. That's true cross the board no matter what system you are trading. Anyone tells you otherwise just walk away they are not being truthful.

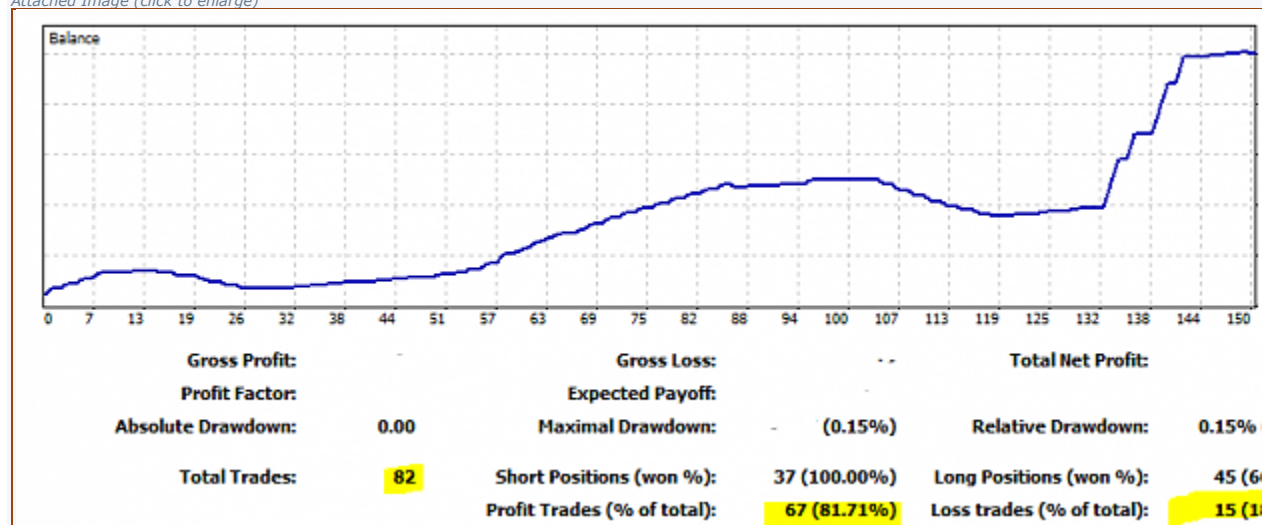

Ever thought why AN closing spread is monstrous? Its intentional. GU spike down was intentional while institutional traders were building longs! That's clear to see now.

Be smart fight them back with positions that are wide and small which allows you to get in and out in profit and without stress. Spikes don't touch your aim is the Entire cat not just the head! Think about that.

Don't Confuse the Concepts of Winning and Losing Trades with Good and Bad Trades

A good trade can lose money, and a bad trade can make money. Even the best trading processes will lose a certain percentage of the time. There is no way of knowing a priori which individual trade will make money. **As long as a trade adhered to a process with a positive edge, it is a good trade**, regardless of whether it wins or loses, because **if similar trades are repeated multiple times, they will come out ahead**. Conversely, a trade that is taken as a gamble is a bad trade regardless of whether it wins or loses because over time such trades will lose money.

"RISK MANAGEMENT

Lastly, but very importantly, the issue of risk management. How to take and protect your profits, how to manage your downside. Being able to manage your out-of-the-money positions and minimize your down-side is a crucial aspect of trading success.

Sometimes it is easy to make profits but hard to keep them. Exactly the same problem that keeps traders from being successful in general is also applicable to risk management in particular. It has become fashionable to bandy about the concept of stop losses and where to place them. My risk management actually starts with my 4x1 strategy, and particularly low gearing (**small position size**). It is no good having a sophisticated risk management strategy and then blowing it out of the water with too high gearing.

"Cut your losses and run your profits" is an old trader's adage. I subscribe to it in principle but it is often misunderstood. The higher your gearing the seemingly more attractive the adage – **you have to cut losses or you are dead**. I don't like that approach. **It is unsophisticated**. Again the mysterious impact of randomness will confound and confuse many oblivious to its prevalent role in any trading system, especially its destructive role in mechanical, mathematically formulated entry-based systems. I have a different approach using, multi entry, low gearing strategies that **do not stop future profits by cutting existing temporary losses. Positions need time to mature** and **you can't expect them always to be in the money minutes, hours or sometimes even days after you have entered a trade. Any trade should be able to spend some time on the wrong side of the tracks without you sniffing your nose at its potential profitability.**"

Traders who place stop losses 10-50pips are going to be taken out. Market is designed for that purpose separate you from your money and basically are sitting ducks. There is much randomness in lower TF and this is obvious. Point is to see the bigger picture and build a swing avoiding randomness all together or minimizing its effects.

This pair likely to range in tight zone. I often repeat same trade again when price goes down to my initial 1st batch on it. 9670-50 area nice to build longs again.  
This is how in most cases I trade rangy pairs. Get out wait for dip then get in again. **This technique is essential to maximize income.** Example I got out of AU longs but if price drops below where I got out then I may get in again thus ride the trend in swings or waves taking TP at key levels.  
So its not about 18 pairs but how you enter and exit on few that you got it right.

What I don't do

The move was at 61S or close to it and now price is **more likely then not to collapse** and then go into correction thus **not high probability set up**. 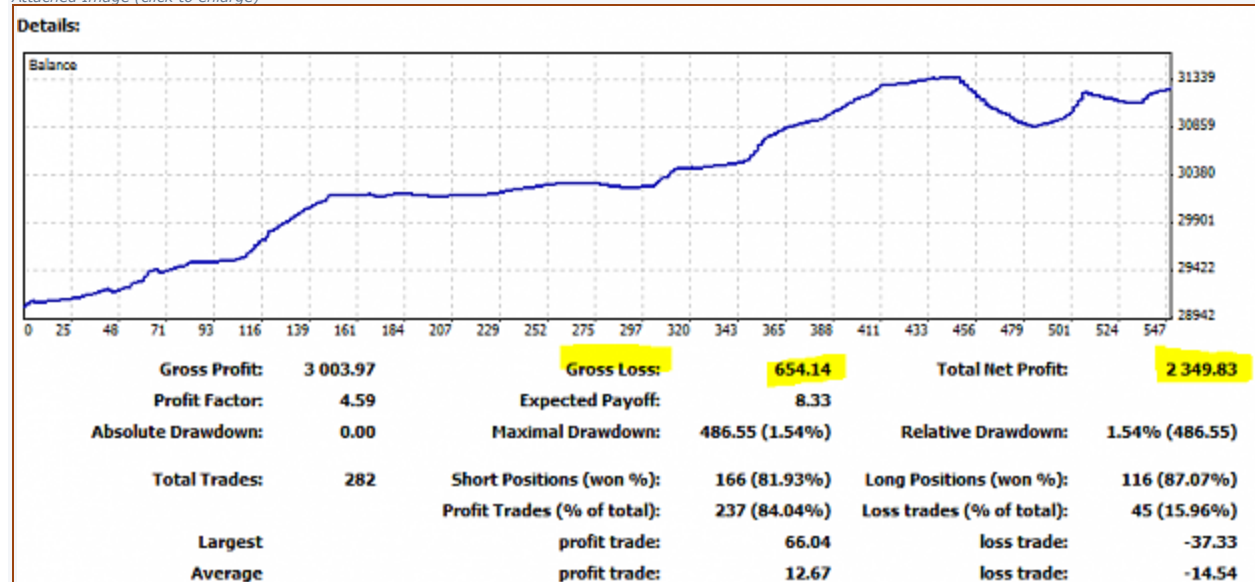
